Prof Dr Lily Chan said: "We are extremely pleased to be partnering with Bonanza Educare to create educational and employment opportunities that will be mutually beneficial for both parties. Our students will potentially

benefit from the internship, training and employment opportunities offered at BE.”

“Through this collaboration, WOU’s pool of experts will share its expertise and knowledge in various areas such as business, science and technology.
